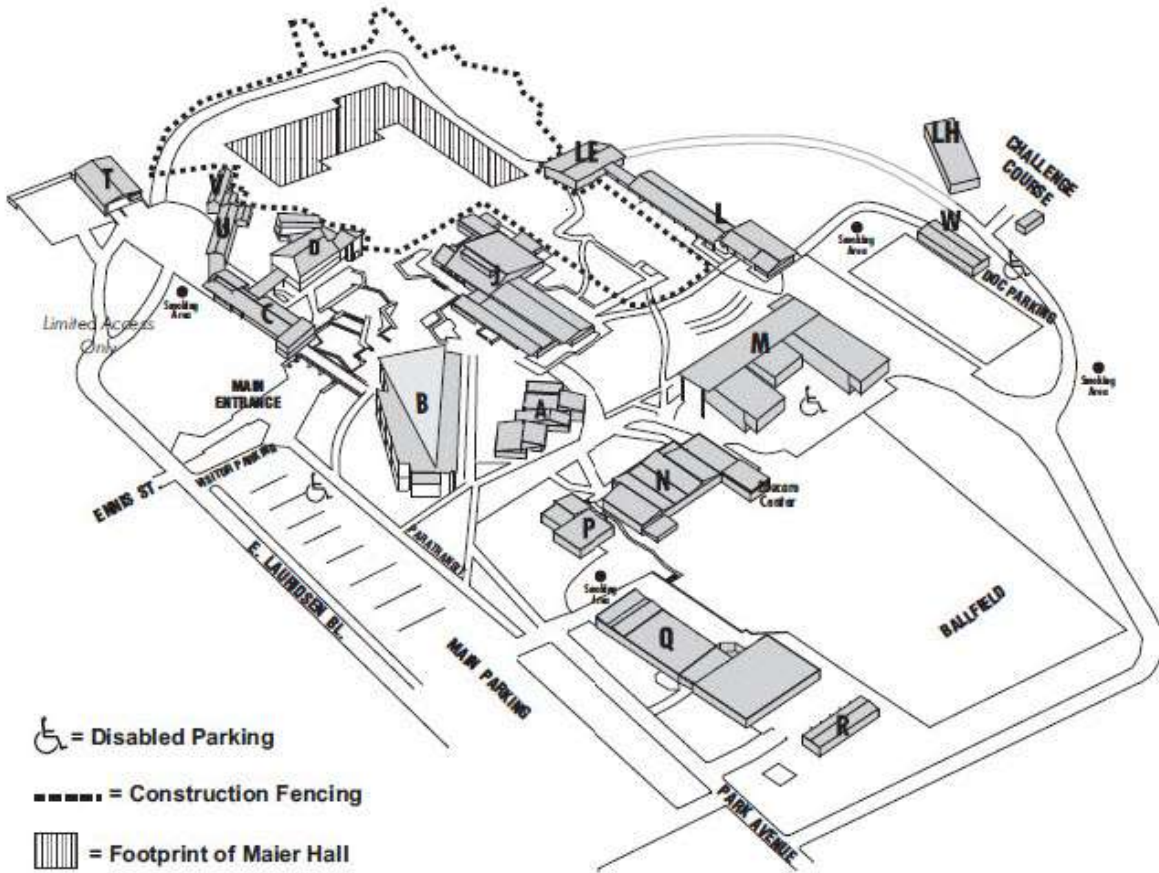


Campus Map
